Dr. Stefan Wolfsberger, a native of Vienna, Austria received his medical and neurosurgical training from the Medical University of Vienna. Following his residency under the supervision of Chairman Professor Wolfgang Koos and Professor Engelbert Knosp, he was appointed Associate Professor of Neurosurgery in 2005. He also completed a postgraduate MBA in Health Care Management at the Medical University of Vienna in 2009.

Dr. Wolfsberger's research interests include advanced imaging techniques in neuroendoscopy, multimodal neuronavigation, 3D visualization, surgical simulation, fluorescence guidance and robotics. He has completed a clinical fellowship with Dr. Sutherland of Calgary, Canada, gaining experience with iMRI and integrating navigation, and 3D imaging with the neuroArm robot.

He has been appointed Adjunct Professor with the University of Calgary Department of Clinical Neurosciences in 2012. Since 2012 he is Assistant Medical Director of the Department of Neurosurgery of the Medical University Vienna.

Since 2010 he has been organizing White Matter - Tractography Workshops in Vienna, Austria and Calgary, Canada.
